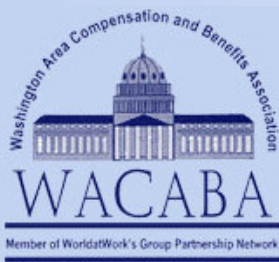
About Our Panelists
